**CORRIGENDUM TO ADVERTISEMENT NO.2732 DT.28.12.2021 FOR
ENGAGEMENT OF INITIAL APPOINTEE TEACHERS**

Pursuant to this office Advertisement No.2732 dt.28.12.2021 applications were invited for engagement of Initial Appointee Teachers and the last date of receipt of the application was 31.01.2022. In para 2 of the said advertisement the age limit for applying for the post was below 32 years and above 21 years as on 30th November 2021.

In the meanwhile, the General Administration & Public Grievance Department, Odisha, Bhubaneswar has amended the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Rule,1989 vide their Notification No.771/GAD dtd.11.01.2022 (copy enclosed) and clarification issued by ST & SC Development Department, Odisha vide their letter No.944 dt.20.01.2022 where in the Upper Age Limit for applying for any post shall be 38 years for the advertisement made during the year 2021,2022 & 2023.

Hence, in partial modification to the said advertisement with respect to fixation of upper age limit is allowed as per the GA & PG Department, Odisha, Notification No.771/GAD dt.11.01.2022. The Upper Age Limit as per Provision of Rule-2 of OCS (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Amendment Rules, 2022 shall be applicable to all appropriate and eligible candidates. All other terms and conditions of the original advertisement will remain un-altered.

Accordingly applications complete in all respect superscribed as **“Application for engagement of Initial Appointee Teacher under SSD Department Schools of Kalahandi District”** are invited from such eligible candidates (the candidates who are in-eligible earlier due to upper age criteria of original advertisement and now eligible as per the age relaxation of the GA & PG Department, Odisha Notification NO.771/GAD dt.11.01.2022) in the prescribed format so as to reached to the **District Welfare Officer, Kalahandi** by Registered Post / Speed Post only by **25th April 2022, 5.00 PM**. No application other than the applications of such permissible over aged candidates will be entertained. The over aged candidates who have already applied and their applications were received within due date need not have to apply again.

NOTIFICATION

Bhubaneswar Dated the 11th January, 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Odisha is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1989, namely:-


1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Amendment Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

2. In the Odisha Civil Service (Fixation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1989, after the proviso to rule 2, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided further that for advertisements made during calendar years 2021, 2022 and 2023, the said upper age limit shall be thirty-eight years.”
