ORDER

In pursuance of Order No. 3856 dated 30.06.2020 of Chief Secretary, Odisha and in view of increasing number of COVID-19 positive cases in and around the Bhawanipatna town I, Dr. Gavali Parag Harshad, IAS, Collector & District Magistrate, Kalahandi being the "Empowered Officer" Under Section-2(1) of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 do hereby impose "**Shutdown**" in the entire **Bhawanipatna town on 25th July (Saturday) and 26th July (Sunday)** to ensure door to door survey and contact tracing so as to contain the spread of COVID-19. During this shutdown only the following activities shall be allowed.


- All medical establishments including hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, medicine stores, movement of Ambulance and all medical personnel.
- District/Block and Municipal Administration/ Police/ Fire Services.
- Central and State Government Officials on emergency duty.
- Telecom Service.
- Petrol Pumps.
- Print and Electronic Media identified by District Police.
- Water supply, sanitization and sewerage workers.
- Electricity supply and distribution.
- Movement of goods and good carries, whether loaded or unloaded.
- Industrial establishments, factories and construction activities.
- Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Services and allied activities, including procurement at Mandis.
- Service Sector Industries including IT/ ITeS, Hotel & Hospitality units. Operation of hotels and hospitality units including their associated offices, movement of staff and associated personnel.
- Road transport on highways, road movement of training vehicles.
- ATMs.
- Home delivery of food, groceries, vegetables and essential items by restaurants.
- Dhabas along National and State Highways/ Major Roads to takeaway only.
- Milk Booths.
- Newspaper hawkers between 5.00 AM to 8.00 AM only.

- Restriction on all vehicular movement (Two-wheelers and four-wheelers) except medical, Govt. officers engaged in emergency duties and others on permission. ^{reasons}

Further

1. Superintendent of Police, Kalahandi will make necessary arrangement for immediate deployment of adequate Police and proper implementation of the order.
2. Sub-Collector, Bhawanipatna will remain in overall charge.
3. EO, Bhawanipatna will look after the logistics.
4. CDMO, Kalahandi will ensure Contact tracing, IEC, active surveillance with provisions of adequate numbers testing and survey team.
5. The shutdown period is effective from **Midnight of 24th July, 2020 to midnight of 26th July, 2020.**

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC and other legal provisions as applicable.
