Sub: Block-wise distribution Order of S. K Oil under NFSA/SFSS for the month of **August & September, 2022.**

Ref: Government in Food Supplies & Consumer Welfare Department, Odisha Letter No.12194, dt.12.08.2022.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to captioned subject, and letter under reference, I am to communicate herewith the distribution of S.K. Oil block wise in respect of PHH/AAY beneficiaries under NFSA-2013 & State Food Security Scheme beneficiaries for the month of **August & September, 2022.** During distribution of S.K. Oil, following instruction of Government may be followed meticulously.

The distribution of S.K Oil shall be made @ 2.500 litres per NFSA/SFSS card per month. The selling price of S.K.Oil shall be fixed basing on the Cost of S.K.Oil per litre at different wholesaler point/ sub-depot released by the District Office and transportation charges as applicable till FPS point.

The ACSO/Inspector of Supplies/Marketing Inspector of the Block/ULB is responsible for correct reflection of selling price by the FPS dealer in the generated slip from PoS device.

The Allotted stocks of S.K Oil should be released only to those fair price shops which have valid FPS license/Renewal for the financial year 2022-23(till Sept, 2022).

Distribution of S.K.Oil at FPS point should be made only through e-PoS device wherever PoS device have been delivered to the FPS. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, such manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned **BDOs/EOs** with proper Justification.

In order to bring transparency in S.K.Oil distribution, Sales Register of exclusive S.K.Oil FPSs have been dropped in the e-Pos devices of composite FPSs (FPS distributing Rice / Wheat). The exclusive S.K.Oil FPS dealers have been given option either to purchase new e-PoS device from Civil Supplies Officer-cum-District Manager, OSCSC Ltd., Kalahandi by applying the full cost of the device (INR 33,630/-) or arrange for distribution of their monthly quota through the devices of the nearby composite FPSs. (FSCW Department Letter No.16279 dt.17.08.2017 under reference).

The Sales Register of exclusive FPSs those who have not purchased new e-PoS devices for sale of S.K.Oil, have been made available in PoS devices of composite FPSs.

The FPS wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above OTPDS URL. The FPS wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the allocation made hereunder and available in the RCMS login MIS Report Section under "Sales Register of S.K.Oil" link for the Blocks/ULBs to download and use during manual transition if any only. The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices of those Fair Price Shops which have received the devices to carry out PoS based distribution of S.K.Oil entitlement of beneficiaries. The other terms & conditions are unchanged and distribution should be made accordingly through e-PoS device taking into consideration of the following points.

- i. Per card entitlement of S.K. Oil shall not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/Marketing Inspector/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- ii. The distribution of S.K.Oil shall be undertaken as per the dateline below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- iii. Undistributed allotment of S.K.Oil will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for the next month.



Sub: FPS-wise State Distribution Order of S.K. Oil under NFSA/SFSS for the month of August & Sept, 2022.

CCSO

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to communicate the district wise monthly State Distribution Order of 19428 KL of S.K. Oil for distribution among all eligible ration card holders under NFSA-2013 and the State Food Security Scheme, for the month of August & Sept, 2022 as per enclosed Annexure-I.

The allotted quota of S.K. Oil should be lifted immediately and distributed to beneficiaries along with rice and wheat allotment of August & Sept, 2022.

The distribution of S.K. Oil shall be made @2.500 litres per NFSA/SFSS card. The selling price of S.K. Oil for the district shall be fixed by the Collector of the district based on the cost of S.K. Oil & transportation charges as applicable till FPS point.

The ACSO/Inspector of Supplies/Marketing Inspector of the Block/ULB is responsible for correct reflection of selling price by the FPS Dealer in the generated slip from PoS device.

THE ALLOTTED STOCKS OF S.K. OIL SHOULD BE RELEASED ONLY TO THOSE FAIR PRICE SHOPS WHICH HAVE VALID FPS LICENSE/RENEWAL FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2022-23 (till Sept, 2022).

Distribution of S.K. Oil at FPS point should be made only through e-PoS device wherever PoS device has been delivered to the FPS. Sales through manual mode should be discouraged as far as practicable. However, in case of any exigencies or in worst circumstances, manual mode of distribution should be resorted to only after due approval of concerned Collector of the District.

In order to bring transparency in S.K. Oil distribution, sales registers of exclusive S.K. Oil FPSs have been dropped in the e-PoS devices of nearby composite FPSs (FPS distributing rice & wheat). The exclusive S.K. Oil FPS Dealers have been given option either to purchase new e-PoS device from CSO-cum-District Manager by paying the full revised cost of the device (INR 33,630) or arrange for distribution of their monthly quota through the devices of the nearby composite FPSs. (FSCW Department letter no 16279 dated 17.08.2017)

However, the exclusive S.K. Oil FPSs those who have not purchased new PoS devices for sale of S.K. Oil should be instructed to purchase new devices from CSO-cum-District Manager, OSCSC Ltd immediately and distribute their respective S.K. Oil quota.

Allotment in favour of FPSs with less than 50 ration cards, suspended FPSs having FPL cards & FPL cards with no FPS has been withheld. The list of such cases has been given

in CSO/RCMS login in separate link. It is requested to update such cases in RCMS (CSO/BDO/DEO login).

The District Civil Supplies Officer is to generate/download Fair Price Shop wise allotment order from the system in CSO login of OTPDS URL www.pdsodisha.gov.in (link given in MIS Report section-"Allotment SK Oil") for each Block and ULB and communicate it to the concerned BDOs/EOs/Sub Collectors/ADMs for further action at their level. Concerned Blocks & ULBs can also download the Allotment in their respective RCMS login in above OTPDS URL. The FPS-wise Sales Registers have also been generated as per the above allocations and made available in the RCMS Login in MIS Report Section under "Sales Register of S.K. Oil" link for the Blocks and ULBs to download and use during manual transaction if any. The FPS-wise Sales Register has also been made available for download in the e-PoS devices of those Fair Price Shops which have received the devices to carry out PoS based distribution of S.K Oil entitlement of beneficiaries. This should be downloaded in PoS device after 1st date of the allotment month and distribution should be made accordingly through PoS device.

- I. Per card entitlement of S.K. Oil shall not be reduced below the prescribed allotment. Minimum 25% verification of sale will be conducted by the Inspector of Supplies/ACSO in charge of the Block/ULB every month.
- II. The distribution of S.K. Oil shall be undertaken as per the dateline below during which all the dealers will keep their shops open and keep sufficient stock for the Consumers.
- III. Undistributed allotment of S.K. Oil will be considered as Opening Balance while finalising the allotment for the next month.




