Introduction:

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya is an ambitious initiative by the Govt. of Odisha to provide quality education in English medium to rural children of Odisha practically at no cost or at best at low cost. It has been planned to open one OAV in each block of Odisha in phased manner. The beginning has been made with 100 OAVs in 100 blocks with effect from the academic year 2016-17 and opening of new OAVs in left out blocks are continuing. All OAVs are being affiliated to CBSE. The entry level is Class-VI and it has been planned to map these institutions centers of excellence with provision of education up-to Class-XII.

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas have infrastructure and facilities of the same standard as Kendriya Vidyalaya with stipulation on Pupil-Teacher ratio, ICT usages, holistic educational environment, appropriate curriculum and emphasis on output and outcome.

Key features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas:

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.
- Vidyalayas have holistic and integral approach touching upon physical & aesthetic development in addition to academics.
- There are 17 rooms in ground floor and 15 rooms in 1st floor including 15 Smart Class rooms and other facilities.
- The Vidyalayas have adequate ICT infrastructure and internet connectivity.
- There is sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
- There is provision of Art, Music and Computer Teacher besides subject teachers.
- Special emphasis is given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
- There is provision of well-equipped laboratories and e-library.
- Medium of instruction is English and the Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
- The Vidyalayas have appropriate pace setting activities, so that Vidyalayas in the neighborhood can benefit from it.
- The classes are from VI to XII with two sections with intake capacity of 40 in each section.
- The reservation of seats for students will be as per the guidelines of OAVS.
- All efforts will be made to make it really a centre of excellence.

Curriculum for +2 Higher Secondary (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas:

1. There will be 5 subjects in class-XI. These are:
 - (i) **English Core (Code 301)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (ii) **Mathematics (Code 041)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (iii) **Physics (Code 042)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (iv) **Chemistry (Code 043)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (v) **Biology (Code 044)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
2. Apart from the above 5 subjects the following subjects are to be offered as Elective / 6th Optional Subject.
 - (i) **Physical Education (Code 048)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks] /
 - (ii) **Painting (Code 049)** [Theory 30 marks + Practical 70 marks] /
 - (iii) **Information Technology (Code 802)** [Theory 60 marks + Practical 40 marks]
3. There is no alternative subject in addition to above 6 subjects. All 6 subjects of class-XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
4. Each subject carries 100 marks.

5. The physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects have practical of 30 marks and theory of 70 marks. Students need to pass in Theory and Practical / IA separately

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas:

The Co-Scholastic activities are used as both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exploring the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following these co-scholastic subjects:-

- (i) General studies.
- (ii) Health & Physical Education.
- (iii) Work Experience.

Admission Guidelines:

- There shall be no qualifying marks to apply for admission in Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya in Class XI(Science) provided the candidates should have passed Class X with Mathematics Standard (041) if coming from CBSE Affiliated Schools or passed Class X with Mathematics as a subject if coming from BSE / ICSE and other Boards.
- Order of preference for admission should be given as mentioned below
 1. Students of own OAV.
 2. Students from other OAVs of the district.
 3. Students from OAVs of other districts.
 4. Students from Govt./Govt. aided high schools within the same block.
 5. Students of Private high schools within the same block.
 6. Students from Govt./Govt. aided high schools of other blocks of the district.
 7. Students of Private high schools of other blocks of the district.
 8. Students from Govt./Govt. aided high schools from other districts.
 9. Students of Private high schools from other districts.

This practice shall continue till class XI is opened in all Odisha Adarsha Vidyalayas. In all cases the selection shall be on the basis of merit i.e. the marks secured in their last CBSE/BSE/ICSE examination. In case of same marks, seniority on the basis of date of birth will be considered and if date of birth also same, lottery will be drawn to prepare the selection list.
