Introduction:

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan (OAVS) provides free quality education to the students in CBSE affiliated Schools, especially from semi-urban and rural areas, across the state. The Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya aims to promote the rural talents by inculcating the 21st century learning skills through a holistic and integral approach for their physical and aesthetic development, apart from academic fineness. This co-ed School is established at the Block Headquarter in all the 314 Blocks of Odisha, at Secondary and Senior Secondary level from Classes VI to XII. The Adarsha Vidyalayas will play a key role in spreading modern education in remote parts in the State, while integrating the students of small towns and villages with mainstream education.

Key features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya:

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.
- Vidyalaya will have holistic and integral approach touching upon physical & aesthetic development in addition to academic.
- There are 17 rooms in ground floor and 19 rooms in 1st floor including 18 class rooms and other facilities.
- The Vidyalayas have adequate ICT infrastructure and internet connectivity.
- There is sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
- There is provision of Art, Music and Computer Teacher besides subject teachers.
- Special emphasis is given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
- There is provision of well equipped laboratories and e-library.
- The Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
- The Vidyalayas have appropriate pace setting activities, so that Vidyalayas in the neighborhood can benefit from it.
- The classes are from VI to XII with intake capacity of 40 in each section.
- The reservation of seats for students will be as per the percentage of SC & ST population in the respective Blocks at Entry level (Class-VI).

Curriculum for Senior Secondary (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas:

1. There will be minimum 5 subjects in class-XI. These are
 - (i) **English Core (Code 301)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (ii) **Mathematics (Code 041)** [Theory 80 marks + IA 20 marks]
 - (iii) **Physics (Code 042)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (iv) **Chemistry (Code 043)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (v) **Biology (Code 044)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks]
 - (vi) **Physical Education (Code 048)** [Theory 70 marks + Practical 30 marks] / **Painting (Code 049)** [Theory 30 marks + Practical 70 marks] / **Information Technology (Code 802)** [Theory 60 marks + Practical 40 marks]
2. There is no alternative subject in addition to above 6 subjects. All 6 subjects of class-XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
3. Each subject carries 100 marks.
4. Students need to pass in Theory and Practical / IA separately in each subjects.

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas:

The Co-Scholastic activities are used as both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exploring the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following three co-scholastic subjects:-

- (i) General studies.
- (ii) Health & Physical Education.
- (iii) Work Experience.

Minimum Eligibility for taking admission into class XI:

- A student belonging to the General / OBC / SEBC must have secured 55 % and above marks in aggregate along with minimum 50% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined) in class X board examination (CBSE or any other Board).
- A student belonging to the SC / ST category must have secured 50% and above marks in aggregate along with minimum 45% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined) in class X board examination (CBSE or any other Board).
- A student should apply for admission in one stream only.
- All notifications and circulars issued by CBSE shall be followed for subject combination in Class XI as per stipulated guidelines.

Order of Preference for Admission:

- a. Students of own OAV (Including students selected for ICONIC OAV)
- b. Students of other OAVs (of same district, not having Class XI) selected for ICONIC OAV.
- c. Students of other OAVs (of same district, not having Class XI)
- d. Students of other OAVs (of same district, having Class XI)
- e. OAV students of other districts.
- f. Students of the Government / Government aided High Schools within the same block.
- g. Students of Private High Schools within the same block.
- h. Students of Government / Government aided High schools of other blocks of the district.
- i. Students of the Private High schools of other blocks of the district.
- j. Students of Government / Government aided High schools of other district.
- k. Students of the Private High schools of other district.
- l. Students of other states

Students selected for ICONIC OAV, Bhubaneswar is eligible for taking admission in Science stream only.

Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of merit i.e., the marks secured in Class X Board Examination (CBSE or any other Board)
