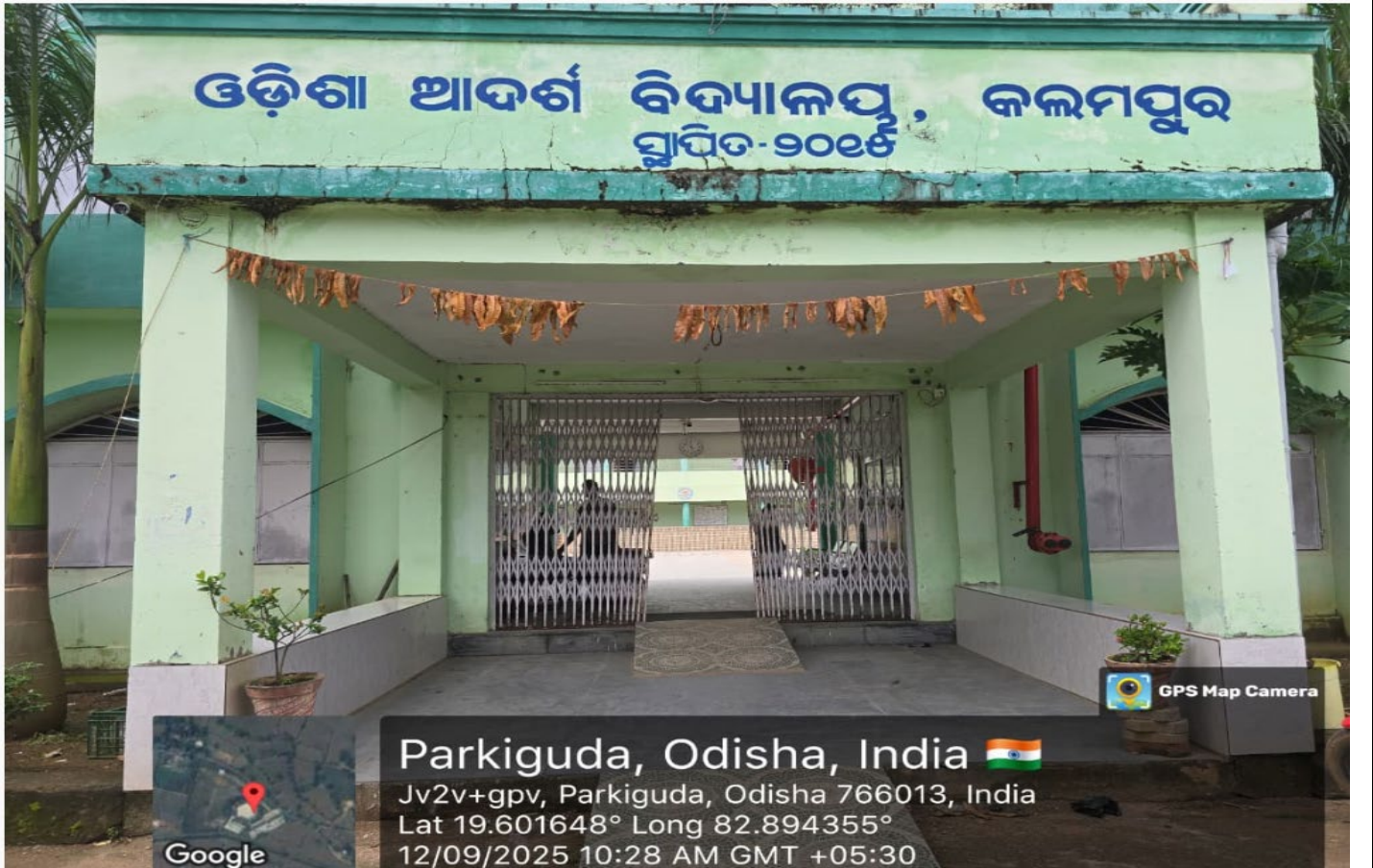

Back ground

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan (OAVS) is a path breaking initiative of Govt. of Odisha to provide free quality education to the students in CBSE affiliated Schools, especially from semi-urban and rural areas, from across the state. The Adarsha Vidyalaya aims to promote the rural talents by inculcating the 21st century learning skills through a holistic and integral approach for their physical and aesthetic development, apart from academic fineness. This co-ed School is established at the Block Headquarter in all the 314 Blocks of Odisha, at Secondary and Senior Secondary level from Classes VI to XII. The Adarsha Vidyalayas will play a key role in spreading modern education in remote parts in the State, while integrating the students of small towns and villages with mainstream education.

Key features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Kalampur:

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium education to the rural talents.
- Vidyalaya will have holistic and integral teaching upon physical, aesthetic development in addition to academic improvements.
- There are 17 rooms in ground floor and 13 rooms in 1st floor including 14 class rooms and other facilities.
- The Vidyalaya will have adequate ICT infrastructure.
- There will be sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
- There is provision of Art and craft, Computer Teachers besides subject teachers.
- Special emphasis will be given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
- There is provision of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, IT, Math Laboratories.
- There is provision of ATAL Tinkering Lab and Library-cum-e-Learning Space for modern learning methods.
- Medium of instruction is English and the Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
- The classes will be from VI to X having two (02) sections in each class and for XI & XII having (01) sections in each class with intake capacity of 40.
- The reservation of seats for students will be as per the percentage of SC & ST population in the respective Blocks.
- There is also 50% reservation for Girls.

Curriculum for Class XI (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas:

1. The Science Stream of each school will have 40 seats
2. There will be 7 subjects in class-XI. These are

(i)	English Core	Code 301 (COMPULSORY)
(ii)	Physics	Code 042 (COMPULSORY)
(iii)	Chemistry	Code 043 (COMPULSORY)
(iv)	Mathematics	Code 041
(v)	Biology	Code 044
(vi)	Information Technology	Code 802
(vii)	Painting	Code 049

3. Students can choose any 3 subjects from (iv to vii) along with the compulsory subjects(i to iii). All 6 subjects of class-XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
4. Each subject carries 100 marks.
5. The Physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects have practical of 30 marks and theory of 70 marks.
6. In English & Mathematics there will be 20 marks for Internal Assessment and theory of 80 marks.
7. Information Technology subject has practical of 40 marks and theory of 60 marks & Painting subject has practical of 70 marks and theory of 30 marks.
8. Each subject will be allotted with practical periods.

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas:

The Co-Scholastic activities are used as both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exploring the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following three co-scholastic subjects:-

- (i) General studies.
- (ii) Health & Physical Education.
- (iii) Work Experience.

There will be allotment of 2 periods per week to each co-scholastic area and assessment will be through grades (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2 and E).

Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission in Class XI (SCIENCE):

- A student belonging to the **General/OBC/SEBC** must have secured **55% or above marks in aggregate** along with **minimum 50% marks in both Mathematics & Science (combined)** in Class X Board examination.
- A student belonging to the **SC/ST** category must have secured **50% or above marks in aggregate** along with **minimum 45% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined)** in Class X Board examination.

Order of Preference for Admission in Class XI (SCIENCE):

- a. Students of own OAV (Including student selected for ICONIC OAV).
- b. Students of other OAVs (of same district, not having Class XI) selected for Iconic OAV.
- c. Students of other OAVs (of same district, not having Class XI).
- d. Students of other OAVs (of same district, having Class XI).
- e. OAV students of other districts.
- f. Students of Government/ Government aided High Schools within the same block.
- g. Students of Private High Schools within the same block.
- h. Students of Government/ Government aided High Schools of other blocks of the district.
- i. Students of Private High Schools of other blocks of the district.
- j. Students of Government/ Government aided High Schools of other district.
- k. Students of Private High Schools of other district.
- l. Students of other states.

Note: Merit list shall be prepared on basis of merit i.e. the marks secured in Class X Board examination (CBSE or any other Board) after fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria.
