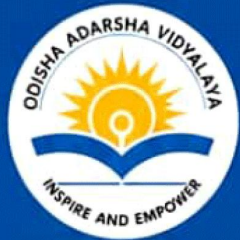
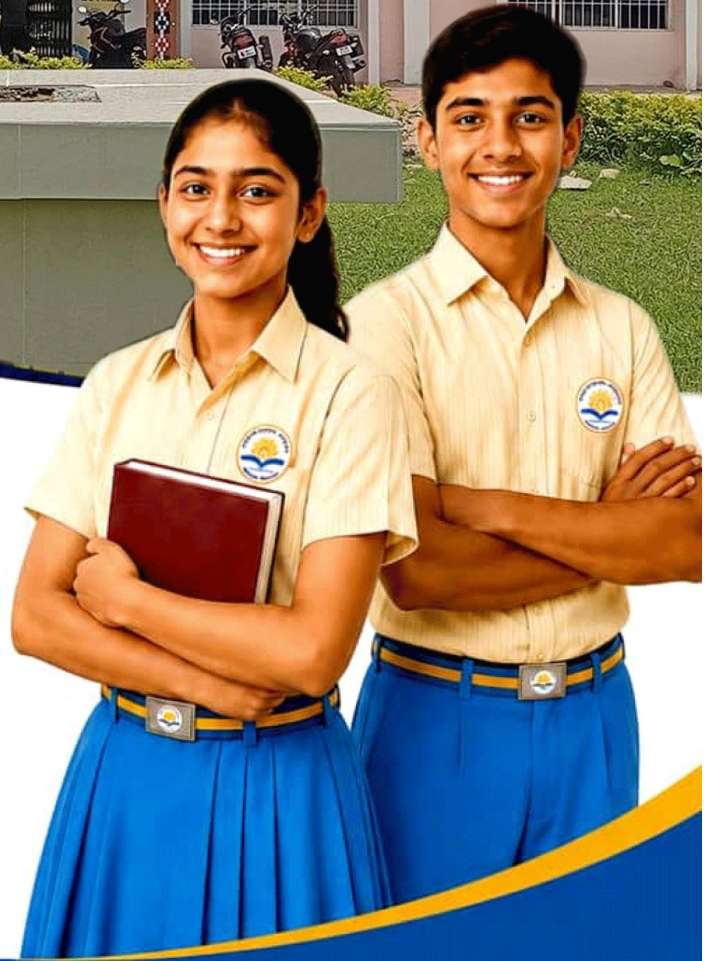

Background

Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya Sangathan is a path breaking initiative of Govt. of Odisha to provide quality teaching in English medium at Secondary level for the children specially in semi-urban or rural areas and to give scope to rural talents who are unable to afford English medium education. Originally, a new scheme "Model Schools" was launched by Govt. of India under central assistance scheme to provide a good quality English Medium Education at par with Kendriya Vidyalaya in all Educationally Backward Blocks of the state. Subsequently, the scheme has been delinked from central assistance from the financial year 2015-16. After de-linking of the scheme, state Govt. decided to implement the scheme and establish one Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya in all 314 blocks of the state phase wise.

Basically Adarsha Vidyalayas will have infrastructure and facilities of the same standard as Kendriya Vidyalaya with stipulation on Pupil-Teacher ratio, ICT usages, holistic educational environment, appropriate curriculum and emphasis on output and outcome. The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.

Key Features of Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya

- The objective is to provide high quality English medium Education to the rural talents.
- Vidyalaya will have holistic and integral approach touching upon physical & aesthetic development in addition to academics.
- There are 18 rooms on the ground floor and 13 rooms on the 1st floor including 16 class rooms and other facilities.
- All classrooms are digitally equipped with smart boards.
- The Vidyalaya will have adequate ICT infrastructure and internet connectivity.
- There will be sufficient scope for sports and co-curricular activities.
- There is provision of Art, Music and Computer Teacher besides subject teachers.
- Special emphasis will be given on teaching of Science, Math and English.
- There is provision of well equipped laboratories and library (Having more than 2000 nos.).
- The medium of instruction is English and the Vidyalaya is affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi.
- The Vidyalayas will have appropriate pace setting activities, so that Vidyalayas in the neighborhood can benefit from it.
- The classes will be from VI to XII having two (02) sections from class VI to X with intake capacity of 40 in each section and one (01) section each for Class XI & XII with intake capacity 40 students.
- The reservation of seats for students will be as per the percentage of SC & ST population in the respective Blocks at Entry level (Class-VI).
- Odisha Adarsha Vidyalaya, Madanpur is declared as centre of excellence by the Govt.
- The 100 Seated Girls' Hostel (KGBV Type-IV) of this school is functioning for girls' students.

Curriculum for +2 Higher Secondary (Science Stream)

(A) Scholastic Areas

- The Science Stream of each school will have 40 seats (1 Section with 40 Students).
- There will be a Compulsory Subject: - English Core (301) and 5 Elective subjects in class-XI. These are:
 - Physics (042)
 - Chemistry (043)
 - Mathematics (041)
 - Biology (044)
 - Computer Science (083)

N.B:

Minimum 4 electives must be taken including Physics & Chemistry.

- In addition to the above subjects, Physical Education/ Painting/ Information Technology/ Artificial Intelligence are to be offered as elective/ 6th Optional subjects. All subjects of class-XI will be continued to class-XII without any change.
- Each subject carries 100 marks.
- The Physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects have a practical score of 30 marks and theory of 70 marks.
- In English & Mathematics there will be 20 marks for Internal Assessment and 80 marks for pen paper test.
- In Mathematics the students have to do 10 activities in a year as per the list and guidelines provided by NCERT Laboratory Manual. Accordingly internal marks will be awarded as per their activities performed.
- In English the Internal Assessment (20 marks) will be totally based on Assessment of Listening and Speaking skills.

(B) Co-Scholastic Areas

The Co-Scholastic activities are used so both cognitive and non-cognitive development of students can take place by exposing the child to the lesson on scholastic subjects and non-scholastic subjects. Each school has to keep following three co-scholastic subjects:

- General studies.
- Health & Physical Education.
- Work Experience.

There will be allotment of 2 periods per week to each co-scholastic area and assessment will be through grades (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2, D1, D2 and E).

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- A student belonging to the General/OBC/SEBC must have secured 55% or above marks in aggregate along with minimum 50% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined) in Class X board examination.
- A student belonging to the SC/ST category must have secured 50% or above marks in aggregate along with minimum 45% marks in both Mathematics and Science (combined) in Class X board examination.
- All notifications and circulars issued by CBSE shall be followed for subject combination in Class XI and other academic & non-academic activities as per stipulated guidelines.

Order of Preference for Admission

- a) Students of their own OAV.
- b) Students of other OAVs (of the same district, not having Class XI).
- c) Students of other OAVs (of same district, having Class XI).
- d) OAV students of other districts.
- e) Students of Government/ Government aided High schools within the same block.
- f) Students of private high schools within the same block.
- g) Students of Government/Government aided high schools of other blocks of the district.
- h) Students of Private high schools of other blocks of the district.
- i) Students of Government/ Government aided High schools of other district.
- j) Students of private high schools of other district.
- k) Students of other states.

Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of merit i.e. the marks secured in Class X board examination (CBSE or any other board) as detailed in eligibility criteria.

- Photo copy of resident and caste certificate.
- Photo copy of Aadhar of student and parents (self attested).
- Blood group certificate.
- Three recent colour passport size photographs.
- Photocopy of bank passbook.

Documents required at the time of admission:

- School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate issued by the Principal/HM of last school attended (Original).
- Marks Statement (Original + one self attested copy).
- Caste Certificate (For SC/ST/OBC only) issued by the competent authority (Original + one self attested copy).
- Proof of Address (Resident certificate).
- Income Certificate of parents.
- Aadhar card (Original + one self attested copy).
- Bank A/c details (Original + one self attested copy).
- Proof of Blood Group (Original + one self attested copy).
- Three recent passport size colour photographs as per the sample provided.

Photograph Guidelines:

In photo head should be positioned directly facing camera, centered and compose 80% of image. Photo should capture from slightly above top of hair to middle of chest.
